탄탄하다 - sturdy/robust(slightly more than 단단하다)

땅땅하다 - sturdy/muscly but short (usually for guys)

당당하다 - confident. 당당한 걸음 Confident walks

담담하다 - calm when facing terrible situations

도도하다 - haughty 도도한 여자

뚱뚱하다 - fat

통통하다 - chubby 그는 뚱뚱하지 않고 통통한 편이야. He's not fat but rather chubby.

똥똥하다 - chubby (slightly less than 통통)

딱딱하다 - hard, firm 그 음식은 딱딱하다 The food is hard (질기다 – chewy)

든든하다 - 1) 든든한 남자 a kind of guy you feel like relying on and can fully trust 2) pleasantly full. 속이 든든하다

튼튼하다 - sturdy, durable 그는 튼튼한 몸을 가졌어. He has a strong body

쏠쏠하다 - lucrative 비트코인은 쏠쏠했어

쓸쓸하다 - lonely, empty 쓸쓸한 발렌타인 데이 Lonely Valentine's day (I am O.K. For Real)

쌀쌀하다 - chilly 오늘 날씨가 쌀쌀하다 It is chilly today.

살살하다 - be easy on someone / do gently 살살해줘 (can be useful for Jacob/Susan.

Overwatch! Say 님아 제발 살살해줘요 Sir, please be easy on me.)
