- 3. 전 <u>회사</u>에 다니고 있어요. (다니다 = go somewhere regularly for certain purposes)
 I work for a company
 (= 전 회사에서 일하고 있어요. I am working at a company)
- 4. 일은 재밌어요? (=일은 재밌나요?) Do you enjoy your job?
- 5. 저의 아버지는 은퇴했어요. My dad is retired.

- 6. 오늘 회사 땡땡이 쳤어요. (땡땡이 치다 = slang. Play hooky)
 I played hooky from work today.
 ** How would you say
 I feel like playing hooky today.
 I played hooky from work today to hang out with my friends.
- 7. 내일은 월급날이에요. (월급 = salary; 월=month) Tomorrow is payday.
- 8. 우리 회사는 월급이 (너무) 짜요. (짜다 = salty, stingy, cheap) Lit. My company is (very) stingy with my pay. Used when you don't get paid for what you do.
 - ** 그는 너무 짜게 군다. He is being too cheap
 - ** 너무 짜게 굴지마! Don't be too stingy!
- 9. 제 연봉은 10 만달러에요. My yearly salary is 100,000 dollars.
